

General Information & Conduct Guidelines

- Attitude and participation are the keys to a successful Youth program. Youth and adults are encouraged to display a positive and enthusiastic attitude about the program, its leadership, and all of its activities.
- Youth are expected to be with the group and a part of program at all times while on site. Leaving the group once the youth has arrived without leadership approval could subject the youth to Disciplinary Action.
- All leaders and participants are called to respect one another and reflect that in their relationships.
- Adult leader's instructions are to be adhered to immediately. If a student has an issue with a directive given by an adult the student, may *upon immediate compliance with the directive* discuss the directive with the youth director or leader of the event.
- Language should reflect a Christian attitude, thus profanity and "put-downs" are not consistent with the group culture.
- Practical jokes are not practical or amusing. Remember to respect others... no practical jokes.
- Drop-off and pick-ups times are posted for most events. Please be on time for both.
- Inappropriate public displays of affections are inconsistent with group culture. Youth and adults will refrain from these displays with proper decorum.
- Weapons, Drugs, Fireworks, Tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, and sex are not a part of any youth function. Possession these substances or illegal drugs, coming under the influence of such products, or acts of these sorts will result in immediate disciplinary action.
- There is to be no male/female alone time.
- No pets are to be brought to a youth event unless with prior consent.
- Respect is to be given to the adult leaders and other youth.
- Violent or sexually oriented music, books, or posters are not allowed.
- Respect others comments, opinions, ideas and feelings.
- Treat the property of others including the church with care
- Cleanup will be done by all prior to leaving any meeting or event.
- Medical Release forms will be signed before any off-site trips can be taken.
- Additional guidelines may be posted at any time, including specific guidelines for off campus activities.
